

Early Learning Network Conference Calls for Program Administrators and STAR 3 & 4 Directors July 2009

What is the purpose of the call? These calls are designed to provide administrators or directors of ABG Pre-K programs, Head Start Supplemental Assistance Programs, and Keystone STARS 3 and 4 child care centers with information on the Early Learning Network (ELN) and its implementation across the state. The Work Sampling System and the Ounce Scale are a vital part of ELN. The calls will discuss how these child outcome databases will be linked with other electronic information currently collected about programs, providers, families and children.

Who should participate? These sessions are designed for program administrators from Accountability Block Grant Pre-Kindergarten Programs, Head Start State Supplemental Assistance Programs, and directors from Keystone STAR 3 and 4 child care centers.

Do I need to participate in more than one call? No, the same material will be covered on each of the calls.

What will I learn? Participants will be provided with:

- an overview of how the Work Sampling System and the Ounce Scale work with demographic databases in ELN;
- information on how programs and providers can prepare for implementation of ELN;
- details about how providers will receive their ELN user names and passwords; and
- information on additional ELN resources and supports that are available to programs and providers.
